



Participants/Parents/Chaperones:

In an effort to eliminate some of the confusion and congestion during this year's parade, please utilize the LDS Meetinghouse (East Kaysville Stake Center) on the corner of 600 East and 250 South (yellow highlighted circle) as a drop off location for your children/participants (**NO DROP OFFS ALLOWED IN THE STAGING AREA**). There is a 3-foot gap in the fence at the southwest corner of the intersection of 600 East and 250 South (red triangle) to facilitate access to the Parade Staging Area (red highlighted circle). I would advise having your children/participants in place no later than 0930 the morning of July 4, as we will begin lining up shortly after 1000 and starting the parade promptly at 1100. Please bring sunscreen and water, dress accordingly, and keep hydrated, as temperatures this year are expected to be in the low 90s. Bathrooms will be available throughout the Staging Area. As a reminder, **NO THROWING CANDY/MERCHANDISE FROM MOVING VEHICLES/FLOATS.....use walkers to disperse goods instead.**
