

WELCOME TO DAVIS DANCE ACADEMY'S NINETH ANNUAL PARADE CAMP!

We will be meeting at the D.A.T.C. parade staging area on Monday, the 4th of July at 10:30am. You may park in the church parking lot at 600 E. 250 S. There is a hole in the fence to get through to the staging area. No cars will be allowed in the staging area this year. The roads close at 10:30 sharp. The parade will begin at the D.A.T.C. road **(300 S. & 500 E.)** It starts at 11:00am. We will hopefully be in the top 20 entries. Look for us at the front of the line in the staging area. **Please check our web site that morning, so if there is any last minute information we need you to know, we can make sure you have it.** We will put it on the Home Page. We don't want this to be a frustrating morning for any of you, so please be on time! **Please take your child to the restroom just before you leave them with us.** We apologize, but with this many children, we cannot take anyone potty.

After the parade, you may pick up your child at Kaysville Elementry. 100 N. 100 E. We should be done with the parade by 12:00pm. **We must have everyone picked up by 12:30pm.** Please remember this is a holiday for our teachers and they want to get to their families as soon as possible. Traffic will be heavy, so please plan accordingly.

If your child has a red star on their hand, they are on the driver's right hand side. If they have a blue star, they are on his left. Please make sure they have their hand marked all through the camp and on the 3rd. If they are riding on the float, please seat them on the correct side when you drop them off. (We have marked your child's hand with a RED STAR / BLUE STAR.) Please get a seat for you and your family accordingly. For your convenience, we have included a map of the parade route on the back of this letter. It also shows where the Kaysville Elementary school is so, **you know where to pick up your dancer. 100 N. 100 E.**

Please make sure your child has red or blue **non-denim shorts (please, no basketball or long shorts)** on with their parade shirt, white ankle socks and white tennis shoes. For those walking in the parade, (ages 7 and up) make sure your shoes are broken-in so that you don't get blisters. It isn't a good idea to wear new shoes! You need to do your hair up off your neck so you aren't hot...and put on lots of sunscreen! Don't forget about the part in your hair if you have one, and your ears and neck. **Please use red/white/blue curling ribbon to tie the sleeves of your t-shirt up, as well as curly ribbon in your hair.** (Dollar stores sell this ribbon for cheap). If you'll just roll the sleeves up three times, then tie the ribbon from the arm to the neck on both sides, it will look really cute! (For an example: see the picture on the dance bulletin board, in the hall by the office). Remember your **disposable water bottle with your name on it.** We've found that its a great idea to fill it up part way the night before and put it in the freezer. Then, fill it up the rest of the way just before you come. Parents of children on the float, **please make sure the flags stay with the float when you pick up your child.** We reuse them each year. (If you want you may put a red, white, or blue visor on the **children riding on the float,** to help with the sun. (No marching children may have visors.) They will slide around when they dance.
